

It is likely that you will be interviewed by your chosen educational institute over phone or video (e.g. Skype) for a few minutes to verify your supplied details with you. This is also an opportunity for the educational institute to understand your command in spoken English, and to get to know you briefly.

It is important that you always remember the information you have provided before in your CV and in your SOP. During the interview do not become nervous. Stay and sound confident, be yourself and take your time to answer in detail in clear and logical manner. Do not just answer any questions by yes or no unless you need to. Remember that any institute, college or Uni has the right to refuse your application for enrolment.

Possible interview questions

- Why did you choose our college/institute/University?
- Have you applied to any other college/institute/University?
- This course is available in your home country and you have good quality Universities and/or colleges. So why have you chosen an Australian educational institute?
- How this course will help you in future? Why have you chosen these subjects?
- How much tuition fees are you going to pay for the full duration of your course and/or per semester? Who is going to finance your study in Australia? What do your parents do? How much do they earn per annum?
- Have you ever been refused student visa in Australia? If yes, when and why Australian government has refused your visa?
- Have you taken any IELTS or PTE or TOEFL test? What's your score?
- Are you planning to do any job while you study with us? How many hours of work will you be doing?
- Who is going to or how your living expenses going to be financed during your stay in Australia?
- Do you have any relatives or friends in Australia? Where will you be staying when you get there?
- Have you read our fees and return policy? Do you know how, when and how much you will get refund if you ask for it?
